The new centre, Silver Centre, is a 17-storey A Grade building with 13,700 m<sup>2</sup> total gross floor area, offers a range of workspace options, a fully equipped conference centre and ground floor retail outlets. It is located in the large JinAn District, a 10 minute taxi ride to the prestigious Nanjing Road West CBD, famous for business, designer shops, luxury hotels and serviced apartments.

Reception services are provided in the building lobby by highly trained bilingual staff.

In the same building, Regus has a business centre on the top three floors, with state-of-the-art technology and professionally trained administrative and IT personnel to run the centre. A Conference Centre takes up the whole of one level with capacity for

up to 300 people for meetings, conferences or training sessions and a restaurant with seating for 80 people.
